SECTION 3 FEE REQUIRED

3.01 Connection and Inspection Fee - At the time of application, a connection and inspection fee shall be included at the following rates.

Checks are to be made payable to the Town of Orange, Sewer Department.

Minimum fee to be charged is \$1,000.00. For multiple units, there shall be an additional charge of \$1,000.00 per unit.

One unit -----	\$1,000.00
Two units -----	\$2,000.00
Three units -----	\$3,000.00
Four units -----	\$4,000.00
Etc.	

SECTION 4 - GENERAL CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- 4.01 All discharges authorized shall be consistent with all terms and conditions of this application, the Town of Orange sewer ordinance, and all State and Federal regulations.
- 4.02 At the time of this application the applicant is responsible for notifying the Town's Plumbing Inspector of the proposed connection. The applicant shall obtain all other necessary permits to complete the project.
- 4.03 The applicant shall notify the Highway Superintendent to acquire a Road Opening Permit.
- 4.04 The Inspection/connection fee must be paid to the Town in full prior to beginning construction.
- 4.05 No work shall begin until the applicant receives full approval of this application. The Town reserves the right to require a 45 day review period for all applications. The Town also requires a 48 hour notice, prior to connection, for inspection of the connection.
- 4.06 If this application for sewer connection is rejected, the applicant will be reimbursed for the connection/inspection fee.
- 4.07 The Board of Sewer Commissioners or designee reserves the right to require a change of materials, design alterations, or additional information to be submitted considered pertinent to the project.
- 4.08 Depending on the size and/or scope of the project, the Town reserves the right to require plans and design specifications from a qualified engineer for said project.

SECTION 5 - TRANSFER OF PERMIT

- 5.01 Any sewer system extension or connection permit authorized to connect to the public sewer system is only valid for the person to whom it is issued, unless transferred pursuant to this section. Such permits shall be automatically transferred to a new permittee if;
- a. The current permittee notifies the Board of Sewer Commissioners or designee at least 30 days in advance of the transfer date; and
 - b. The notice includes a written agreement between the permittee and the proposed transfer permittee that includes specific information for transfer of this permit and liability to the new permittee to remain consistent with the permitted design for the project.
