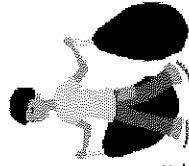


**WE ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC:**

**NON-RECYCLABLE ITEMS**

NO black plastics  
 NO beer or soda cartons  
 NO window glass, light bulbs, auto glass, china, candle holders, etc.  
 NO plastic bags, flower pots, or bulk styrofoam

***These items go in your trash bags.***

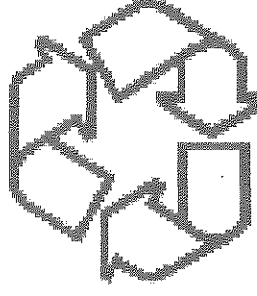
